Information for Patients

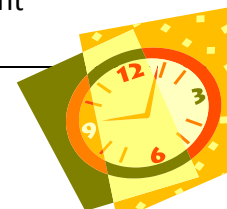

APPOINTMENTS

All surgeries are by appointment, and can be made in person or by telephone, as well as via the internet. We offer a mixture of pre-booked and on-the-day appointments.

If you are unable to attend for your appointment please let us know so that we can offer this to another patient.

URGENT APPOINTMENTS

We have urgent appointments each day for the Doctor. After 1pm each day one Doctor is on Duty for all urgent requests.

(Urgent appointments are not for Repeat Prescriptions, fitness for work certificates or for signing forms).

MINOR INJURY CLINIC

Our nursing and medical staff can provide treatment for many minor injuries. Tell the receptionist and she will alert a member of the Practice Team as soon as possible.

HOW TO REGISTER AS A PATIENT

If you are new to the area and you need to register with one of our GPs, please ask at our Reception. If you have your Medical Card then bring this along with you. If you are on regular medication, please tell the receptionist who will book you an appointment to ensure your medications are added.

HOME VISITS

Home visits should only be requested for those who are unable to come to the Surgery because of serious illness and infirmity. They should be requested before 11am if at all possible.

Whenever possible we prefer to see you at the Surgery; if you do not feel well enough to sit in the waiting room we can make alternative arrangements. Requests for visits after 1pm will be taken by the Duty Doctor.

TELEPHONE ADVICE

All Doctors are available to give telephone advice after their morning surgery. Patients are advised to telephone before 11am to arrange this.

DISABLED ACCESS

The flat/ramped surface is suitable for wheelchairs. Disabled toilets are available off the waiting room.

PRESCRIPTIONS

Both surgeries have dispensaries which will issue prescribed drugs to eligible patients. If you live within one mile of an independent Pharmacy we are not permitted to dispense to you. Please note we are unable to take card payments.

ROUTINE — requests for repeat prescriptions will be dealt with within three working days. This can be in-person, through SystmOnline or via our Managed Repeats Service.

URGENT - requests for urgent prescriptions will be ready to be collected by 3pm the same day, but please try to request these in person.
